Adventure Outpost: Climbing and Kayaking campers will spend the week living and camping at the Outpost on Camp Glisson property and at Standing Indian campground in the Nantahala National forest near Franklin, NC. Campers will climb a rock face while wearing a harness and attached to a belay system. Climbing will be facilitated by staff trained by Fox Mountain guides in climbing and rappelling. Adventure groups will kayak on the Chestatee River in Dahlonega. Transportation will be provided by Lumpkin County school buses and professional drivers or camp vehicles and staff. Campers will be in their adventure group with three staff members, each of whom are trained in First Aid and at least one of whom is Wilderness First Aid and Lifeguard certified. While at the climbing site, emergency services are approximately an hour away. While on the river, emergency services are approximately 30 minutes away. The group will be in touch with main camp at least once a day. Camp Glisson provides adequate group gear and supplies for each trip yet camper are subject to extremes in weather at all times. Campers will be held responsible for their own behavior while participating in this Adventure Outpost camp.
